Stroke in children?

Strokes happen in infants, toddlers, school-aged children and teens—about **5,000 US children every year**—and cause lifelong disability. As common as childhood brain cancer.

*Strokes in babies get labeled as “cerebral palsy.” **Millions of children** around the globe are living with stroke disabilities.*

They can occur in **healthy children**, and in children with predisposing conditions like *congenital heart disease* or *sickle cell disease*.

They happen more in **children of color**, and economically-disadvantaged children.

The causes of childhood stroke are **different** from those in adults, but children also need the devices and drugs developed for adults.

We have learned a lot about cerebrovascular disease in children in the past 2 decades...but still have *more questions than answers*.

Founded in February 2019, we are a global organization of health professionals and scientists who care about **stroke and cerebrovascular disease in childhood**. We developed out of our original collaborative network, the International Pediatric Stroke Study (IPSS), and now aim to broaden the scope of our mission beyond research.

Experts across related fields collaborate to advance knowledge on mechanisms of childhood stroke and stroke recovery with an eye towards preventing stroke and improving outcomes. IPSO will **disseminate knowledge and best practices** to first-line medical providers for the wider benefit of children with stroke worldwide. Throughout, IPSO will engage affected families to set priorities and **advocate for children** with cerebrovascular disease.

IPSO Founding Members' Congress



- Originally planned for 2020, the congress took place **April 24-26, 2022**, in Vienna, Austria
- Registration opened *only 3 months in advance* due to multiple geo-political hurdles
- Despite these challenges, the meeting was an overwhelming success
- *Exceeded registration targets*: 100+ in-person registrants from 19 countries
- 57 speakers (in-person and virtual) including a pediatric stroke survivor and patient advocate
- 34 posters accepted
- All key disciplines represented: neurology, neuro-interventional radiology, neurosurgery, rehabilitation medicine, hematology, psychology, physical and occupational therapy

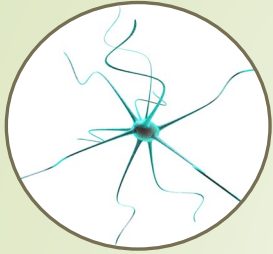
