

# We're Recruiting ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

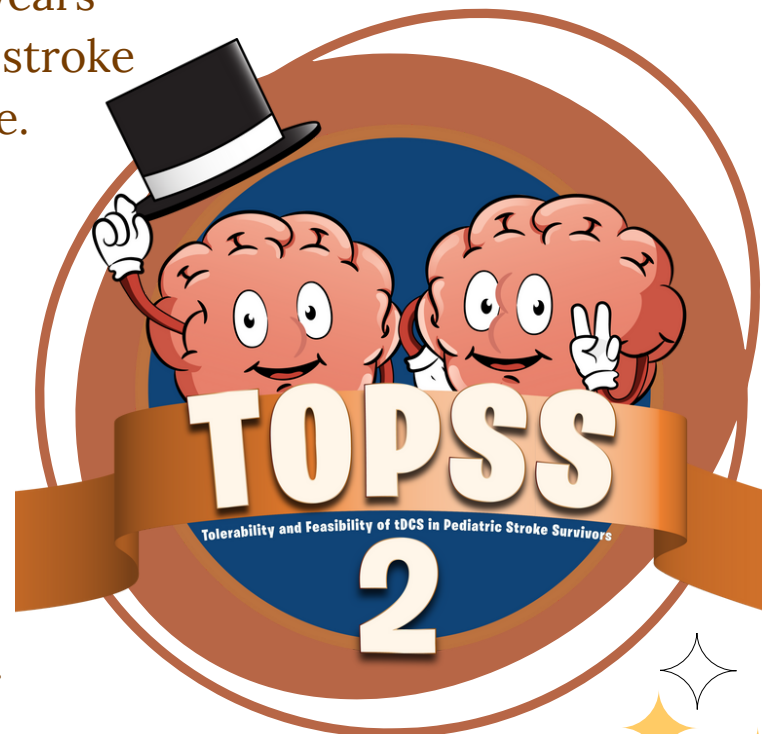
Children between the ages of 5-19 years old who have arm weakness from a stroke are potentially eligible to participate.

## WHAT'S BEING STUDIED?

Transcranial Direct Current Stimulation, a non-invasive form of brain stimulation, is being tested in conjunction with conventional occupational therapy for arm weakness after a stroke. Study participants will receive 2.5 hours of therapy per day for 10 days.

## WHAT'S THE PURPOSE YOU MAY ASK?

This research study is examining the tolerability and feasibility of Transcranial Direct Current Stimulation (tDCS) in children with arm weakness after stroke.
